

Create a character profile

This is a great activity for having children showcase their comprehension and inference of a book or story.

Learners will need to think about the author's use of adjectives and storytelling in order to outline a character's personality, appearance and the journey they go on.

Print out the activity sheet on the next page, or use it as a template for creating your own. If you don't have access to a printer, learners can also write out their answers in their workbook or notebook.

To get the most out of this activity, the child might need to refer to their current reading book. Run out of reading books at home? Organisations like Book Trust and Oxford Owl have free online libraries of children's books. You could also create a profile for a film or TV character instead!
